CURRICULUM:

RELIGION

- Students will grow in their knowledge and practice of the virtues, understanding how virtue leads to happiness and looking to the lives of the saints as models of the virtues.
- Students will understand how to navigate the Bible and key teachings from the Bible, such as Creation, the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, and the Last Supper.

ENGLISH/LANGUAGE ARTS

- Students will grow in reading comprehension and critical thinking, and apply skills in independent reading and book clubs.
- Students will understand the writing process, and compose narrative, informational, and persuasive pieces.

MATH

- Students will master multi-step addition and subtraction, problem-solving, as well as solving word problems using multiplication and division.
- Students will increase proficiency of multiplication and division, fractions, and decimals.

SCIENCE

- Students will study the Earth’s surface, living things, and their environment.
- Students will analyze forms of energy with a focus on electric currents, and study complex machines through construction of various models.
